

is entitled МЕЛОДИИ В ТАНЦЕВАЛЬНЫХ РИТМАХ (in English: MELODIES IN DANCE RHYTHMS) and has ORHESTRA listed on the gatefold sleeve as a performer. Researches revealed that instrumental cover versions are performed by the band with the name (according to various sources) Mexicali Banditos or Torero Band.
